## THIS WEEK

In Maths these week, we've been finding equivalent fractions, decimals and percentages by looking for clues in the number patterns and carrying out investigations.

In English, we've began our unit on the poem Beowulf, with a focus on the punctuation, grammar and writing techniques. Ask your children to tell you what a semi-colon is and when it should be used (they should be able to give you an accurate answer!).

In Science and Geography, we looked at volcanoes around the world and various facts about them. It was really interesting learning about the most dangerous volcano in the world! Do you know which one it is?

## NEXT WEEK

Next week, we'll be starting our new topic of learning in Maths: adding and subtracting decimals. The children have spent a lot of time learning about decimal places, and will be able to apply their knowledge to a different context. Very useful when it comes to shopping!
