### Maths

Make your own fruit salad using your favourite fruits. Count how many pieces you have of each fruit. Make a bar chart or a pictogram showing the results.

Which fruit do you think is the lightest? Which is the heaviest? Weigh your fruit to see if you were right.

Explore cutting your fruit into halves and quarters.

Create a survey to find out the favourite fruits of people in your family.

### RE/PSHE

Think about the differences between our lives and those of other people in the world. Are their lives more difficult? Why?

Think about the similarities we share with others. What do we have in common with children on the other side of the world?

Do you have any friends or family in other countries? Who are they and where do they live? How do you keep in touch?

Write a prayer/poem to celebrate the differences and similarities of people around the world.

### Geography

Do you know your full address? Learn your address and practise writing it. Can you find your address on a map?

Choose a country to research. What is the weather like there? What animals live there? What is school like there? How long would it take you to travel there and what form of transport would you use? You could show your research in a fact file or a poster.
