

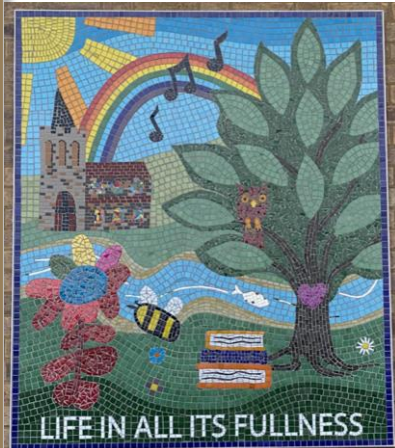
## Bourn's Magical Book Bus!

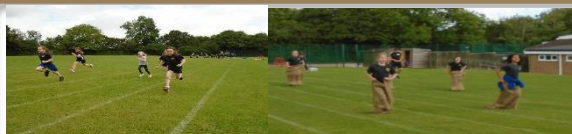
